



## How to get to Kingswood School - SS16 5DE



Basildon can be reached by A127 (from A12 or M25) or A13 (from East London or Dartford river crossing M25). Use the A176 from the A13 or A127. At Basildon Town Centre take Southernhay, pass the station on your right and take the next right under a bridge into Clay Hill Road. Take the second left at Papworth Trust and the entrance to the car park is from second right. Terling.

**Kingswood School**

By rail Basildon is on the Fenchurch St. to Southend line. From the station turn right onto Southernhay and follow the railway line, then as above.

## SECTIONS

The Congress will be divided into six sections as listed below. All competitors will play in all six rounds. As far as it is possible, people with equal scores will be paired against each other according to the official rules for Swiss Tournaments.

All ages are taken at 31.8.15.

E.g. The **Under 6** is for competitors who were aged under 6 on 31.8.15.

**Under 18** for competitors who were aged under 18 on 31.8.15. This is the upper age limit for Junior Competitors. The **Under 18** is run within the **Basildon Open Rapidplay Championship**. Players may enter for the section for which they are qualified or in any higher age group if preferred.

### Parents Room

A room will be set aside for adults as only competitors and officials are allowed in the playing hall.

## Rate of Play

In all sections players will have twenty minutes plus ten seconds added per move to complete all their moves. This means that games should finish within one hour. Those that go on for a prolonged length of time may be adjudicated. Players who have not used clocks before will receive instruction in their use before the first round commences.

The organisers reserve the right to combine two age groups into one section if, in their opinion, numbers are insufficient for a worthwhile competition.

### London Junior Chess Championships

To qualify for the London Junior, competitors in the Under 8 must gain at least 4 points out of their 6 games. In Under 10 and Under 12 a score of 3.5 or 4 points qualifies for the Minor and 4.5 or more for the Major.  
The U6 section is not a London qualifier.

### ECF Grading

All sections will be submitted for ECF Grading
